
Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey


G.G.D.S.D. College, Hariana




How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 59 responses


How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




How well were the teachers able to communicate? 59 responses




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 59 responses



Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 59 responses




Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 59 responses




The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



















What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching. ⁵⁹ responses








The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.
